The Decktet is a fabulous thing from another world, a six-suited deck of cards that can be used to play dozens of different games.


This set comes with a few reference and summary cards, but I've learned better than to compress the rules of whole games onto cards. For rules and more information, visit the website:

This set is two copies of the Decktet with different illustrations and card names.

 One copy is the Classic deck. You can tell it apart because all of the card names start with "the".

 The other copy is the CAPITAL deck, and the card names start with an upper-case "THE".

The difference lets you easily sort the cards into two separate decks, or you can shuffle them together to make a double deck.



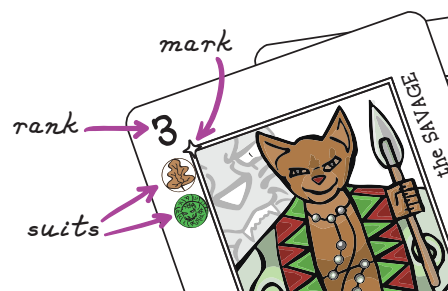
Cards in the Decktet are distinguished by having different suits, ranks, and marks.

Some cards have two or even three suits.

 For example: 


The Savage is a rank 3 card that belongs to both the suit of Leaves and the suit of Wyrms.

It has a ♠ mark, indicating that it is a face card.



The core of the Decktet, the basic deck, is 36 cards:

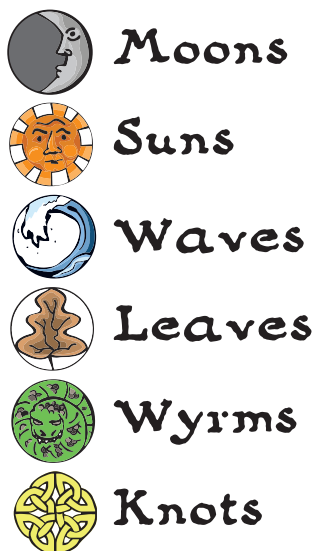
6 Aces,
24 number-rank cards,
and 6 Crowns (♠).

 There are also some extended deck cards:

4 Pawns (♠),
4 Courts (♠), and
an Excuse.

The extended extras are a bit like Jokers in a mundane deck of cards. Leave them out unless the rules for a game specifically say to include them.
